Also, for completeness and transparency, I present to you a detail account of my operations during my 2009/2010 term. The attached annual report was ready for mailing already last year, but it was not published due to my precarious health situation. Also, I would like to inform members and delegates, who will vote for the new By-laws of the Division in the upcoming Elections on March 28, 2011, that only with small changes, the entire draft of the proposed By-laws was prepared during my administration. Although the report is long, I would like to familiarize you with the most significant accomplishments realized while in office. It will convince you to appreciate the solid foundations laid already. In addition to the traditionally organized during my term, there realized many innovative projects which visibly distinguish my administration.

- In May and October of 2009, PAC-IL submitted proposals of many resolutions to the National PAC. American Agenda was adopted October 17, 2009. See <http://www.pac-il.org/accomplishments.asp>
- Summer festival in Yorkville was reintroduced and combined with the onsite voter registration by the Illinois Election personnel
- Initiated by „Wspólnota Polska” in November and December a framework of cooperation with the Polish University Clubs was established. Also, cooperation with Polish Saturday Schools was established.
- Preparation and introduction of a framework of cooperation with „Wspólnota Polska”
- Three times our Division organized political forums at the White Eagle: for Polish-American candidate, republican and democratic candidate. Each session was combined with the onsite registration by the Illinois Election personnel
- Installation of a brand new premiere website <http://www.pac-il.org>
- Preparation of a proposed draft of the Division By-laws
- Announcement of a scholarship for the “Studniówka” students to be presented at the Pulaski Day Banquet

While in office, I initiated many constructive projects which set in motion a revival of the Illinois Division. I hope that you will join me on this road of reform continuation efforts. I believe that once you acquaint yourself better with mine and my PAC-IL administration achievements for the period 2009/2010, then I can count on your support of my candidacy. Because by working together in our organization for the benefit of building the Polonia's image you will prove to all that We can, We must, and We will change the image of the Polish American Congress in the state of Illinois.
